To whom it may concern:

"Baxter" Bell (owned by Shirley Bell) recently participated in a study through the cardiology department at the Ontario Veterinary College to investigate arrhythmogenic right ventricular cardiomyopathy (ARVC). As part of the study, "Baxter" had a Holter (ambulatory ECG) performed. This test revealed the following:

- 18 hours and 26 minutes of recording were reviewed. This revealed a total of 93718 normal beats. No premature ventricular contractions (VPC's) were noted. The Holter was unremarkable (ie: normal)
